### ABORIGINAL RESEARCHER SUPPORT GRANT

## **Purpose of the Grant:**

To support and encourage Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people working as researchers, or with an interest in research, to build their research skills, experience and confidence.

# **Eligibility:**

- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person
- Currently employed or involved in a research-related role and/or interested in a career in research
- Living and working located in central Australia

### **Grant criteria:**

- 1. Grant requests are up to \$1000.
- 2. This is a one off grant opportunity within a 12-month timeframe.
- 3. Successful applicants will submit a <u>brief</u> report once grant-supported activities are complete, along with an expenditure report.

## How to apply:

Applications must include:

- A short statement (up to 300 words) outlining how the applicant will use the grant and how it will contribute to building skills, experiences and confidence in research. A brief budget outline should also be included.
- 2. A short statement (up to 300 words) from the applicant's employer outlining why they support the applicant's Grant application

#### Please note:

There is no closing date for the grant. Applications are individually assessed by a CA AHSN review panel.
